## What is it?

## When?

**How does it work?** Children should bring their books to the library on the morning of the swap between 8.40 and 8.55am. They can then exchange these for a token which can be 'spent' at the Book Swap shop.

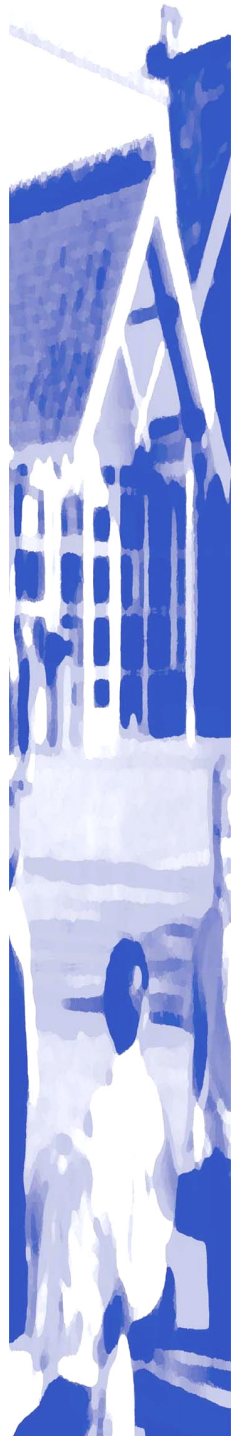
**Please remember!** We aim to offer the children a good quality selection of popular books, so please bear the following in mind:
