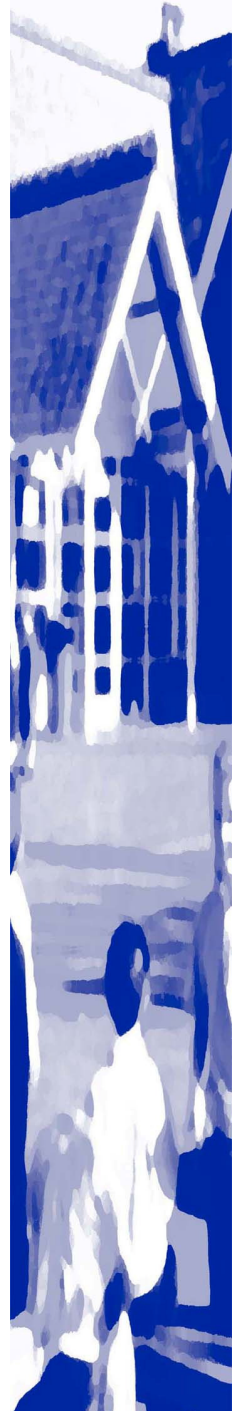
Nativities!
