Dear Parents,

With our Year 5 residential trip to Avon Tyrrell a little over two months away, our team would like to give you further details of the centre, activities, timings and kit required.

Day 1 - Monday 26<sup>th</sup> March

Please drop your child off at Avon Tyrrell, outside the main building, between 8.40am and 9.00am. Also make sure your child has alerted a member of staff to their arrival before you go, as they will be directed to the cabin area that we have acquired as our meeting point.

Arrivals are not normally expected until after mid-day, so we have a short walk and teacher led activities planned for early morning before we are allowed into the main building.

Please ensure your child has a filled water bottle on arrival and that it is carried in a backpack with a suitable wet weather coat. Children should also wear suitable walking shoes; however Wellingtons will not be necessary. Sun cream and a hat are recommended as a precaution if not slightly optimistic!

Avon Tyrrell will provide lunch on the first day.

**Days 2 to 4**

From Monday evening until Thursday afternoon children will be undertaking the following activities with qualified instructors:

Archery, Climbing, Abseiling, Low Ropes course, Mountain Biking, Problem Solving, Kayaking, Disco and of course the traditional barbeque on the final evening.

Although Avon Tyrrell staff will be leading the activities, all groups will be supervised and supported by staff from our school. We have also planned in some free time for the children to enjoy with each other.

## Day 5 - Friday 30<sup>th</sup> March

We are able to stay on site until 12pm therefore we are requesting that you pick up your child, again from the main house between 11.30am and 12pm on the morning of Friday 30<sup>th</sup> March.

### Meal times

8.00am - Wake up call

8.30am - Breakfast

1pm - Lunch

6pm - Dinner

There are vending machines on site to buy additional drinks and snacks should your child wish - there will be one trip to the vending machine per day as directed by the adult group leader.

There are also a few souvenirs available to buy on the last afternoon. We recommend pocket money should not exceed £6 in coins, no notes please as change is not available. Please provide your child with a water bottle to allow them to drink during the activity sessions.

The children will be accommodated in the main house and will be provided with bed linen and pillows. **Towels and toiletries however are not provided.**

We also advise the following items are packed as a minimum:

### **1 x Rucksack containing...**

1 x Filled water bottle

1 x Wet weather coat (trousers too if you have them)

1 x jumper

1 x hat (and sun cream - you never know!)

Please wear suitable walking shoes on the first morning - trainers with good grip are fine.

### **1 x a named main case/bag containing...**

2 x towels

1 x swimming costume

1 x wash bag that includes shower gel, toothpaste, toothbrush and deodorant.

5 x t-shirts

7 x underwear/socks

2 x fleece/jumper

2 x trousers (long, preferably not jeans for activities in case they get wet)

2 x pair of shorts

1 x set of night wear



- A named wallet or purse containing pocket money
- 1 x reading book
- 2 x pairs of trainers (one pair for wet activities)
- 1 x bin liner (dirty/wet clothing)
- 1 x sketch book (optional)
- 1 x disposable camera (optional)

Each individual item of medication must be clearly named and placed into a secure tupperware box that is also named. Please keep this outside your main case on the first morning and hand it to a member of staff as soon as you arrive.

Each named item of medication must have a set of instructions detailing how often your child must take it.

Finally, please could you complete the medical form attached with this letter and let us know of any changes prior to the trip.

Please also note that I believe the clocks are due to change on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> March!

We are all looking forward to what is sure to be a fantastic week. Please feel free to catch me at any point prior to the trip with any last minute questions.
