Our new IPC unit after half term is 'Survival - Food and Farming'. This unit will continue into the Summer Term until Whitsun half term.

During this unit we will be focusing on geography, history, ICT, science and technology:

- In geography we will be finding out about the food that is grown in our own and different countries
- In history we will be finding out about and making some of the food that people used to enjoy
- In ICT we will be finding out about the world food situation and about agriculture
- In science we will be growing plants, finding out why milk is kept cold and finding what's inside an egg
- In technology we will be looking at farm buildings, growing and making some food of our own and making bread and butter.

We are in the process of booking a visit to a local farm during the Summer Term.

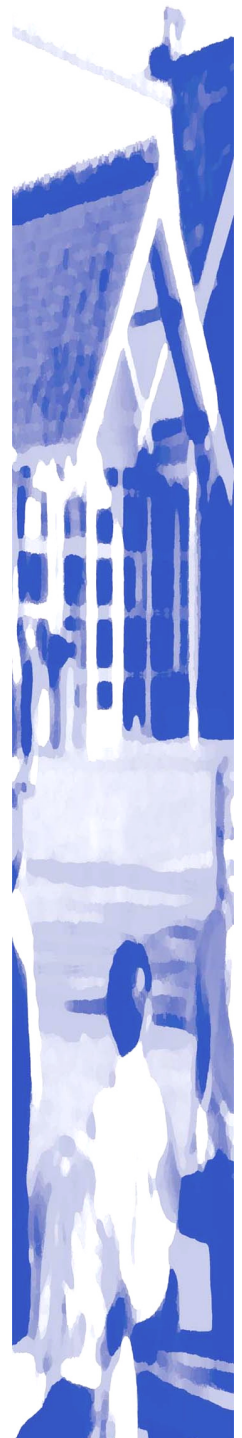
