In **Science** we will be finding out:



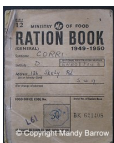
- ❖ why we need to eat food and what the best foods are and how some of our food grows

Our Entry Point will take place during lunchtime on **Monday 18th January** where your child will have the opportunity to taste cuisine and experience a different culture from around the world focussing on Asian foods. The menu consists of the following:

Thank you so much for your continuing support and have a very Creepy Crawly Christmas and a bug filled New Year.


