- similarities and differences between toys from the past and today

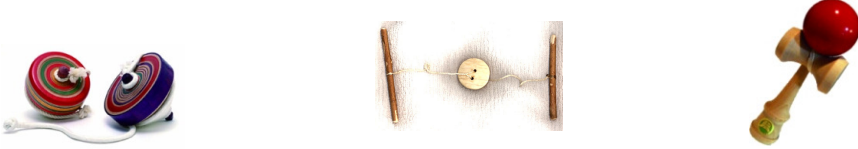
In Science we will be finding out about:
