

## Information for disabled visitors

### **Firstly, welcome!**

Bransgore School wants you to be able to visit us and not feel unwelcome.

The school layout provides some difficulties for access because parts of the building are Victorian. We have three sets of internal steps, because the school is built on a slope.

However, we do have outside ramps so that access can be gained to any part of the school.

We also have an adult unisex toilet/hygiene room for disabled people.

If you anticipate any problems for your visit, our best advice is to telephone the school office prior to your visit. We can then discuss how best to facilitate your needs.

Parking is best achieved in the church car park next to the school. A gate will enable you to access the flat front playground. There is a ramp up to the main entrance door.

(The staff car park is always over-crowded and very little space available. It does not access the main route into school.)

On arrival at the main doors, there is a buzzer to press. These doors open outwards and may be a little difficult. Please let the office team know if you have any problem.
