

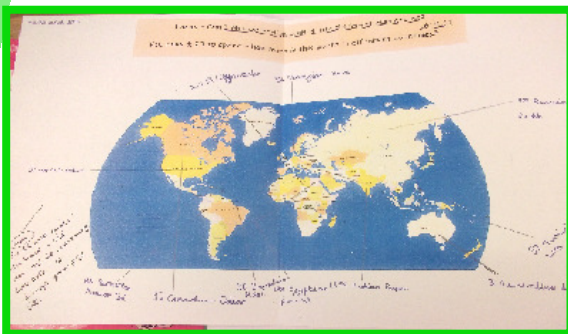
Geography at Bransgore
