

## Year 5 & 6 visit to the Imperial War Museum, London

Dear Parents/Carers,

As an exciting part of our learning about life on the Home Front during World War II and to extend the children's understanding of WWI and the events that led to WWII, we will be making two educational visits to the Imperial War Museum, London.

- Year 5 to go on Wednesday 6th February 2019
- Year 6 to go on Thursday 7th February 2019

I will be leading the trip on both days and will be accompanied by other members of the teaching team. We would also like to ask if any DBS checked parents would like to accompany us, ideally we need 5 for each day. I have pre-visited the museum and selected the exhibits most useful to our learning. We will not be visiting the Holocaust exhibit as this is covered in Secondary school history.

Children will travel by Laguna Coaches leaving school at **7.00am sharp**. Meaning children need to be at school at 6.30am please.

We will leave London at 2.30pm and hopefully be back at Bransgore at around 5.30pm, but this is obviously dependent on traffic conditions. We will let the school office know of our progress and they will text parents with a more accurate arrival time on the day.

## Children will need:

- To wear school uniform/shoes and have a coat.
- Have breakfast before they leave as we will only be making a short toilet stop on the way
- Bring a **snack to eat & a drink** for when we arrive (hopefully about 10.00am).
- Bring a packed lunch.

If your child is likely to be travel sick please make sure they have had medication at the appropriate time and a suitable breakfast before the journey. We can give medication for the return journey but you will need to complete some paperwork with the office and this medication will be kept with first aiders and given to the appropriate child by an adult.

To cover the cost of the trip we are asking for £11.30 per child. The entrance to the museum is free so this cost covers the coach travel and insurance fees. This is a voluntary contribution, however, if we do not receive enough contributions we will not be able to go ahead with this visit. We receive funding for any families eligible for Pupil Premium, so the cost for these pupils will be paid for from this funding.

Please return the permission slip and contribution by Friday 11th January 2019.
