### New Learning Topic

Our new topic after Christmas will be called 'Toys' Children will learn:

- How toys have changed over time.
- Materials that toys are made of and why some materials are better than others.
- How to design and make their own toy.
- To create their own lullaby.
- How to use and move programmable toys.

We are also providing children with increased opportunities for writing so they can apply their skills to our topic work.

## Home learning for over Christmas



Over the holiday we would love the children to use their artistic talents and create a representation of their favourite toy, it could be one Father Christmas has delivered or one they already have, in any way they choose such as;

- Model (plasticine, papier mache, cardboard boxes, clay)
- Picture (drawing, painting, crayons, felts)

### The launch of our Toys Topic

To launch this exciting new topic we would like the children to bring in a game/toy that they are able to independently explain how to play to their friends (not electronic) on **Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> January.** The children will be playing and reviewing each other's toys and this will link to lots of other writing opportunities. Please ensure the game is clearly labelled with their name or in a named bag to avoid any confusion.

This half term we will be heading to the Forest School site and focussing on maths. We will be going on **Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> February.** Year 1 will go at 9.00-10.00am and Year 2 at 10.40-11.40am. Children should come to school in appropriate clothing for Forest Schools, bringing welly boots and waterproofs to school with them. If you have completed a DBS check with the office and are able to help for either session, please let the School Office know by Friday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2019.
