Year 1 and 2 have had a toy-rific start to the Spring Term exploring, playing and rating a variety of modern toys, thinking about how toys are made and even using different techniques in art to draw our favourite toys!

This half term we are going to be finding out about toys that our grandparents might have played with (if any grandparents would like to raid their attics and lend us any treasured toys to look at that would be amazing!).
