

Recycling <u>Plastic</u> Information for Bransgore Parents

Please note that including incorrect items can disturb the recycling process, so if in doubt – leave it out and put it in your general rubbish or an Eco Brick

| Type of Plastic | Where to Recycle | Includes | Does not include |

| Biscuits and Snack wrappers | Mandy and Jen – 26/27 St Georges' Drive (green box with black lid) | Any brand of: sweet biscuit wrapper (e.g. Digestives), cracker wrappers (e.g. Cheddars, Jacobs) cake bar wrappers like Hobnobs. | |
| Bottles (no bottle tops) | New Forest recycling bag | Only bottles – they don't take any other plastic | Give bottle tops to Mandy & Jen of milk bottles tops to St Mary's Church |
| Contact lenses and contact blister packs | Joanne Davies (mum on school run) | Any brand of soft disposable contact lens + their foil and plastic blister packagin | |
| Crisp packets and Pringles (Please don't fold packets and keep all packets separate) | School: green wheelie bin | Any brand of: crisp packet crisp multipack outer packaging any size Pringles plastic lid and seal + Pringles tubes | Not popcorn or beef snack packets – it's crisps only. |
| Drinks bottle tops (NOT milk – see below) | Mandy and Jen – 26/27 St Georges' Drive (green box with black lid) | Please wash and bag milk bottle tops separately from other bottle tops | |
| Milk bottle tops | St Mary's Church collect milk bottle tops for Mencap | Please wash | |

| Pens | School: purple bucket in reception | Any brand of: pen, felt tip, highlighter, marker correction fluid pot/ correction tape mechanical pencil and eraser pen regardless of their composition. | Do not include wooden pencils, chalk, glue sticks, erasers, rulers or other cutting objects |

| Toothbrush and toothpaste tubes | Mandy and Jen – 26/27 St Georges' Drive (green box with black lid) | Any brand of: toothpaste tube or lid plastic toothbrushes electric or battery toothbrush heads toothpaste cartons | |
| Yoghurt pots and other plastic pots and trays – not black | Christchurch Refuse – place in the smaller 'plastic and can' recycling wheelie bins, which are green in colour, and positioned near the textiles banks | All clear or white plastic tubs, pots and trays | Not black plastic |

PS Don't forget that School takes batteries as well for recycling.
