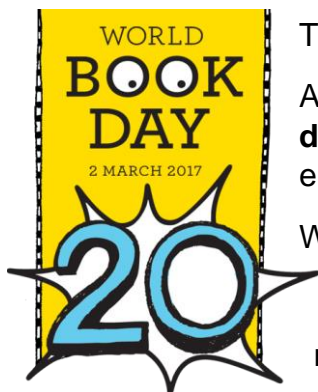

This will obviously differ depending on the age of the children. Foundation stage could enjoy looking at a book for 5-10 minutes, leading to an hour (or more) in KS2.
