SATs Timetable Letter

Dear Year 6 Parents/Carers,

Thank you for all your hard work and support this term in encouraging our Year 6's to be positive about their learning. The SATs assessments start on Monday 8th May. Each day assessments start at 9am, so children need to be on time please.

The timetable is as follows:

- Monday: Reading Comprehension Paper (60 minutes)**
- Tuesday: Grammar Paper (45 minutes) and Spelling Paper (20 minutes)**
- Wednesday: Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic, 30 minutes) and Paper 2 (Reasoning, 40 minutes)**
- Thursday: Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning, 40 minutes)**

As you can see, the individual papers are quite short, so we will continue to teach Maths or English each morning, and have normal lessons in the afternoons.

We will celebrate the end of the assessments with a bacon/sausage/veggie bap on the Friday.

Please will you help your child to eat and sleep well, and we will try to have as normal a school week as possible. Pupils will not be allowed any phones, 'Apple' watches, pencil cases or other gadgets in school.

They have all worked really hard all year, and I hope they will do their best. We will be continuing with English and Maths after SATs week.

Obviously, there will be many trips out and special events for them, such as visits to Secondary Schools, Bikeability, the production, sports day, forest walk, Houses of Parliament trip, etc, so plenty to look forward to.

Please encourage completion of Home Learning tasks; it is not too late to get up-to-date with all the **My Maths** that has been set as it is all **excellent** revision! Reading through their Grammar Study Guide would also be useful.
