**Educational Visit to: The Tutankhamun Exhibition**

Dear Parents/Carers,

To support our history learning about Ancient Egypt we will be visiting The Tutankhamun Exhibition in Dorchester on the above dates. This is a very distant historical age for young children to study, and the visit to this exhibition will offer a unique opportunity to learn about Tutankhamun, ancient Egyptian burials, mummies and Egyptian artefacts. As well as visiting the exhibition, the children will experience an expert led session about Ancient Egypt.

- We will leave school at **9.00am** sharp and return at **1.45pm**, so should be back to school by 3.00pm for a normal end of day. If we are delayed, the school office will be informed who will then send out a text.
- We are travelling by seat-belt equipped 49 seater coaches provided by Laguna Coaches.
- The groups will be led by the Year 3/4 teachers and other staff trained in First Aid with parent helper volunteers. Please complete the attached slip to let us know if you would like to help with your child's class or another class on these visits.
- The museum will be open to the public during the visit, but children will be supervised at all times.
- We will not be visiting the shop in the museum so children **will not** need any money.
- Children should wear normal school uniform and footwear, plus a raincoat or cagoule as there is a 10 minute walk from the drop off point to the museum.
- Children will need a packed lunch, healthy snack and water bottle in a ruck sack.
- Weather permitting, lunch will be eaten at the Borough Gardens or if raining, in the Exhibition's Resource Centre.
- No mobile phones or other gadgets are allowed.
- We expect the usual high standard of behaviour from all children and will employ the usual school system of rewards and sanctions during the visit.

The cost for each child to be admitted to the Tutankhamun Exhibition is £4.95 which includes access to the museum and the expert led session. Therefore taking into account the additional cost of coach travel to Dorchester (£305 per day), we are asking for **£13.95** per child. This is a voluntary contribution.

If we do not receive enough contributions we will not be able to go ahead with this visit. We receive funding for any families eligible for Pupil Premium, so the cost for these pupils will be paid for from this funding.
