English / Read Write Inc.

- Reading We encourage children to access Bug Club at home, however they can also take the physical books home too. If your child is on Read Write Inc. they will also be bringing these books home.
- Writing All children have daily writing opportunities and we are working hard to self improve with a focus on effort rather than outcome.



English cont.

Spelling – In Year 1 children will be consolidating their set 2 and 3 sounds. In year 2 children will begin the Read Write Inc. **spelling** programme.

How you can help at home – Read with your child little and often. Consolidate the sounds they are experiencing in their books. Begin to ask questions about what they have read. Any letter formation/fine motor or writing practice. Display high frequency words around the home and play games with them.

Enhancement: a short time during worship to consolidate class learning





Maths

Children will be taught in groups following the National curriculum objectives for their year. They will be encouraged to make links between the different areas of maths such as number, measure and shape using practical resources. The teachers use a creative mix of videos, games, practical equipment and even art to help children understand some of the trickier concepts.

► How you can help at home -

Number formation (writing and recognising number everywhere!)

Time (reading clocks around the home and analogue watches.

Measure (baking cakes, using rulers and tape measures)

Count in jumps of 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s from any number. (Year 1)

Times tables – 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s (Year 2)

Fortnightly MyMaths will be added online and will be linked to class learning where possible to consolidate what they have learnt in school.

Moving forward in Key Stage 1...

- This year your child will have both a class teacher (known as their animal group) and a key teacher (known as their tree group). The key teacher will be the adult with whom your child will spend the majority of their day.
- We feel that this will be beneficial to both your child and you as parents/guardians as you will have a main point of contact regarding your child and their progress this point of contact will <u>always</u> be with your child's <u>key teacher</u>.
- The key teacher will meet with you at parents evening and be able to discuss all aspects of your child's learning including Maths, English, Topic and any social and emotional issues. The key teacher will also write the report for your child and this will ensure consistency for you as a parent/guardian and your child as a learner.
- ▶ A letter has already been sent out detailing your child's key teacher.
