Please note that for the protection of children all governor appointments are subject to a vetting process and identity check.

If more than one parent applies we will hold an election and you will be sent a ballot paper and details of all candidates standing no later than **Tuesday 31st October.**

Your completed ballot paper and declaration form will have to be received by the school no later than **noon on Friday 10th November 2017** after which a count will take place and the winner will be declared.
