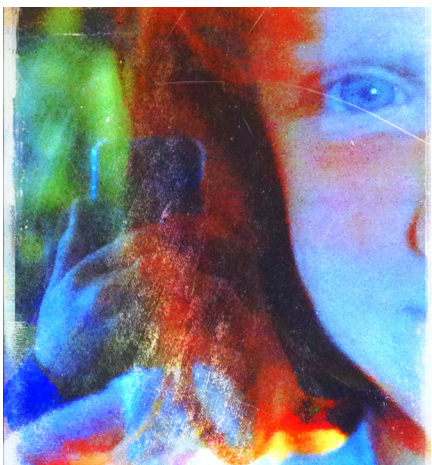

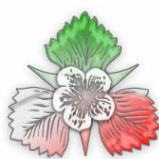

- All entries must be submitted as JPEG files by email to photocompetition@ringwood.hants.sch.uk
 - Images should be labelled with name, photo-title, school and age group. Due to the huge volume of entries, any photographs incorrectly labelled may unfortunately not be considered.
 - Entries are limited to 3 images as a maximum
 - Age categories:
 - Years 4 - 6
 - Years 7 - 10
 - Years 11 - 13
 - A Parent or Teacher
 - The deadline for entries is Friday 23rd March 2018
 - Judging will be carried out in the weeks following the deadline and entrants whose photographs make it to the exhibition stage will be individually invited by their school
 - Short-listed entries will be required to write a short explanation of their image
 - An exhibition and prize-giving will be hosted at Ringwood School
 - There is a runner up and winner in each age category winning prizes provided by the Rotary club (cash vouchers and photographic books)
 - An overall ‘Best in Show’ prize is made on the evening with a trophy awarded
