Our New Topic 'Emergency!'

The children have settled back into the routines and expectations of the class really well and we enjoyed listening to their Christmas adventures during our circle times this week. This half term our topic will be "Emergency" and is all about finding out more about the emergency services with planned visits from the RNLI and the Hampshire Air Ambulance already in the diary.

We had great fun launching our topic with lots of rescues taking place in the classroom!





We are hoping to hold a 'Be a 999 Hero!' on <u>February 8th</u> which will tie in with a visit from the Hampshire Air Ambulance Service, we would like the children to come to school dressed as any superhero of their choice...they could even make up their own! We will be asking for a <u>£1 donation</u> to be made to the Hampshire Air Ambulance and hope to hold a fundraising activity in the afternoon but we will confirm what this will be nearer the time.

If any parents, grandparents or anyone you know has any links to the emergency services and would be prepared to come in and talk about their job and answer some of the children's questions then please get in touch with the office.

Forest Schools

This half term we will be going to the forest a number of times as the children will be continuing their science study, exploring how insects and their habitat change through the seasons and exploring different areas of maths. Our first session will be **Monday 29**th **January**. Children can come to school dressed in their own clothes and bring in appropriate footwear and outer clothing. **Please remember to ensure your child has a long sleeved top, long trousers, appropriate footwear and as we often work on the forest floor they will require waterproof trousers.**

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Reading

Please continue to enjoy reading the books available through BugClub both online or as a hard copy if you prefer, their library books that they bring home, and other books and magazines which they find interesting. Reading with your child for at least 10 minutes every day can have a great impact on all aspects of their learning as this helps to expand their vocabulary.

Important information

- Please can you ensure children are bringing in appropriate **P.E kit** for P.E. lessons, as stated on the Uniform Policy which can be found on the school website. Can you please ensure you book all medications into the school office as there are forms that require completing before we can give medication to your child.
