Battery Hunt!

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you know, we are working really hard at Bransgore to make positive changes to try and help our environment. Our eco-council wrote to you recently to tell you about a number of initiatives we are getting involved with.

We will soon be collecting and recycling your old and broken plastic carrier bags to save them from becoming landfill.

This letter is to tell you about our **“Big Battery Hunt”** sponsored by Duracell.

Before the Easter holiday, your children will be sent home with a Big Battery Hunt collection box. Please can you try to fill the box with used batteries? Hunt them down in your own house and from your friends and family. The project aims to collect and recycle 4 million batteries so please count up the number of batteries you collect in your box.

When the box is full please return it to school and empty the box into our Big Battery recycling bin in the entrance hall. Keep the box and start re-filling again. If you could write on the poster next to the battery bin the number of batteries you have collected that would be very helpful as we do not really want the eco-council to count the batteries themselves in case some have leaked and they come into contact with the acid. If you can write the number on the poster, the eco-council will then add up the total and let you know how we got on as a school. The **closing date for the battery hunt competition is 27th April** so we will be entering our grand total then. HOWEVER the recycling scheme continues after this date so even when the competition is over and prizes have been awarded we can still keep collecting and recycling batteries to help our planet.

Please help our children to do their bit for the world and let's show that our Loving School loves our planet!
