KS1 Village Walk - Thursday 21st November

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our new topic 'where do I live?', we would like to explore the local area by going on a village walk on Thursday 21st November. This will involve a simple observational task that will support their map work in later Geography lessons.

In order to do this, we need your help! The children will be going on a village walk in their classes. As you can imagine, this requires as much adult support as possible to ensure that we maintain a high level of road safety. We are, therefore, looking for 5 parent helpers to support each class walk and we ideally need the same parent helpers to support all 3 classes.

Timings are as follows:

The first class: 9.10-10.05

The second class: 10.10-10.55

The third class: 11.00-11.40



Please note that these are approximate timings based on a pre-route risk assessment, previous timings of a village walk and allowing time for an observational activity.

Parent helpers will have the sole responsibility for a small group of approximately four children (**this may not include your own child**). This will include:

- managing road safety
- ensuring high standards of behaviour
- maintaining engagement of an observational task
- supporting school staff

Please also note that this does not affect the Flu Immunisations.
