Year 5 & 6 Trip to Paulton's Park - Tuesday 24th March 2020

Dear Year 5 and 6 Parents/Carers,

I am very pleased to tell you that our educational visit for next half term is to Paulton's Park, in Romsey. The purpose of this visit is in support of this term's Science topic on Forces.

- The visit will be on **Tuesday 24th March 2020.**
- **We will leave school at 9.00am sharp and leave Paulton's at 3.15pm, so we will be back at around 4.00pm, please note this is later than a normal school day pick-up.**
- We are travelling with Laguna Coaches in two coaches, both equipped with seat belts, which we have used on many occasions.
- Miss Gibaud will be the group leader, Mr Green and Miss Fitzpatrick will also be going, together with a number of Teaching Assistants and parent volunteers.
- Groups will have a ratio of 1 adult to 6 children.
- **Children can wear their own clothes/coat and comfortable shoes/trainers.**
- **Children also need to bring a packed lunch/water bottle in a rucksack.**

During the visit, the children will spend the morning taking part in science workshops, led by the Paulton's Park Education Team, looking at the forces involved in the running of the rides and trying out the rides themselves. We will then all sit to eat a packed lunch, under a covered outdoor area. After lunch, we will have further time to continue to explore the rides, in our supervised groups.

Miss Gibaud and Mr Green have visited Paulton's Park to carry out a risk assessment in line with Hampshire County Council guidelines.

Please do not give your child any pocket money, as we would rather the children made the most of their time enjoying the rides, rather than wandering around a gift shop. Children are not allowed to bring mobile phones. The school can contact any of the staff if there is an emergency. (School number is 01425 672272). We will be taking photos on the school iPads to support our work.

The school's normal behaviour policy will apply at all times and we will withdraw children from activities should we feel it is necessary to ensure their safety or that of others.

To cover the cost of the trip we will be asking for **£15.60** per child. This is a voluntary contribution, however, if we do not receive enough contributions we will not be able to go ahead with this visit. We receive funding for any families eligible for Pupil Premium, so the cost for these pupils will be paid for from this funding.
