Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to share the latest Department of Education (DfE) advice with you. The DfE has told schools that:

- Young people and children should stay at home if they are unwell with a new, continuous cough or a high temperature to avoid spreading infection to others. Otherwise they should attend education or work as normal.
- If young people or children become unwell on site with a new, continuous cough or a high temperature they should be sent home.
- There is now a 14 day whole household isolation if anyone in the household has one of the two key symptoms detailed above.

We will be following this guidance.

The Government's decision is still to try and keep schools open for now, so it's business as usual if you and everyone in your household are symptom free.
