The table below shows the objectives that will be covered during the Sex and Relationships lessons. For the children who are currently in school, we will be covering these lessons before the end of term.

For the children who are at home, we have a printed off the lesson plans/resources which are from our Jigsaw (PSHE) Programme of study which we also follow in school.

The content covered in the Jigsaw programme is in line with government's guidance on Sex and Relationships Education.

Piece 1	I am aware of my own self-image and how my body image fits into that.
	I know how to develop my own self esteem.
Piece 2	I can explain how girls' and boys' bodies change during puberty and understand the importance of looking after yourself physically and emotionally.
	I can express how I feel about the changes that will happen to me during puberty.
Piece 3	I can describe how a baby develops from conception through the nine months of pregnancy, and how it is born.
	I recognise how I feel when I reflect on the development and birth of a baby.

During the past, we have held a meeting in school where we share the lesson materials and any concerns from parents.
