Have you started your Christmas shopping yet? Whatever the answer, I am sure we are all conscious that Christmas is not that far away and we will soon be making preparations for it.

In our comfortable lifestyle, we sometimes find it hard to believe that there are children who will receive little or nothing for Christmas because of the situations within their home countries and communities. At Bransgore School we try to encourage our children to be compassionate and generous and so, with your help, we would like to support the Rotary International's scheme again this year to bring Christmas gifts for disadvantaged children in Albania, Montenegro, Moldova, Romania and Philippines.

The Rotary Club are able to provide some boxes for you to fill and these are available to collect from the school reception today.

Leaflets are provided in the box that gives you all the information on what to fill the boxes with and a label to attach to the box stating age and gender. If you are providing your own box please collect a leaflet from the office as it has the dimensions for the boxes. Please read the leaflet carefully as some items are prohibited.

Rotary International is also asking that, if possible, could you tape £1.50 to the outside of the box to cover administration and transportation costs.



We have been involved with this scheme for several years now, and some children have received letters in return telling them how much the gifts mean to them.

The boxes will be collected from school on **FRIDAY 5th NOVEMBER**, so you have half term to fill them.
