Our New Topic 'Emergency, Emergency!'

The children have settled back into the routines and expectations of the class really well and we enjoyed listening to their Christmas adventures during our circle times this week. This half term our topic will be "Emergency" and is all about finding out more about the emergency services with a planned visit from the Fire Service (government guidelines allowing) and hopefully a paramedic, doctor and policeman. If you are a member of the emergency services or know someone who is that could spare some time either morning or afternoon to come and talk about their role and answer some questions from our very enthusiastic children then we would be very grateful. Our learning this half term will include:

Geography:

- Using and creating our own maps
- Finding where the emergency services are in our area

History:

- Learning about who Grace Darling is and why she is a significant individual of the past
- What lighthouses are used for and when the first lighthouses were built

Art:

Creating a mixed media collage using torn paper and weaving material

Science:

- Finding out about all animals, including humans and what their basic needs are for survival .
- The importance of exercise for humans
- Why humans need a balanced diet including finding out more about the different food groups

ICT:

Children will create a digital picture and talk about the tools that they are using

RE:

They will be learning more about why Jesus is important and become familiar with some of the parables about Jesus and how he has helped Christians.

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Reading:

Thank you for your continued support with your child's reading, we were pleased that so many children made progress with their reading last term and their confidence and enthusiasm to read aloud also increased which was lovely to see. Reading with your child for at least 15 minutes every day can have a great impact on all aspects of their learning as this helps to expand their vocabulary.

This half term, if your child is on the Read, Write, Inc reading program they will be coming home with;

- 1) A **Read**, **Write**, **Inc paper** copy of the book they have been reading with their phonics teacher and they will have read at least twice in their phonics group.
- 2) A Read, Write, Inc 'Book Bag' Book (this is a new element of the Read, Write, Inc scheme that the school has invested in to support your child's reading development) – this is a book linked to their Read, Write, Inc book but your child has NOT read this in school so they are applying their phonic skills to decode the words in this book.
- 3) A colour banded reading book to be changed independently by the child once it has been read 2 or 3 times at home. The wider the range of books your child can read at the correct reading level, the more fluent they will become and their vocabulary will rapidly increase.





Tapestry:

This will also be the way we will be posting home learning if you are isolating so please ensure you are familiar with this section of Tapestry.
