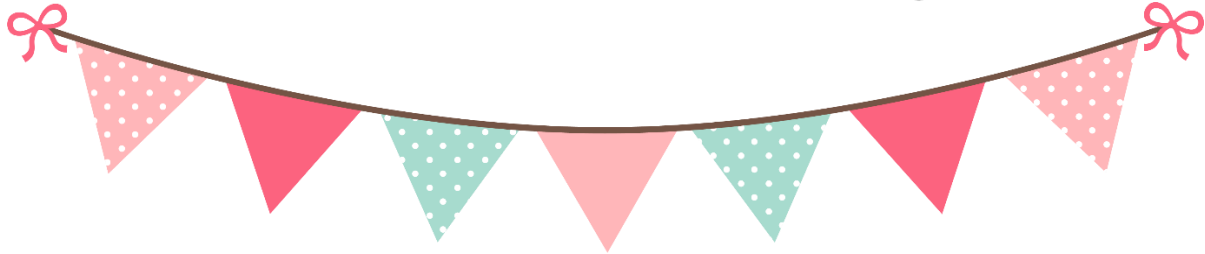

Treasurer

Typical responsibilities:

- Ensuring money/bank cards and cheque books are kept safe
- Banking takings
- Reporting income and expenditure for each event
- Completing charity commission annual return
- Issuing bills and receipts and making payments
- Processing expense claims



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There will be the opportunity for a handover so please don't be concerned too much if you don't have experience but still want to step forward.

Parent/Carer Volunteers
