## **KS2 Sports Day** Mars, Mercury, Jupiter, Saturn, Pluto and Neptune Thursday 30th June at 12.45pm

Dear Parents/Carers.

The Parish Council have kindly offered us the use of the Bransgore Cricket Ground again, as our venue for the KS2 Sports Day. This is a fantastic opportunity to bring our school to the centre of the community and for the children to have a good size track to run around.

### Arrangements on the day:

#### What the children need to wear and bring with them

We would like children to come into school on Thursday wearing their PE kit. They will need: Normal PE Kit. trainers, sun hat, sun cream and drinks bottle. We would also ask that ALL children bring in a packed lunch on this day as timings are very tight and we need to leave the school by 12:15pm.

#### Refreshments

We will provide areas of shade for the children and ensure they have extra water available. Parents and spectators will be able to purchase refreshments kindly provided by the BSA. We would ask that parents bring a picnic rug or their own camping chairs if they wish, as we will only have a few chairs available at the venue.

#### Timings

We aim to start at 12.45pm and have it all wrapped up by 2.45pm (which allows plenty of time to get back to school to collect siblings).

#### Parking and end of day arrangements

There will be limited parking available at the cricket ground and across the road at the recreation ground so I would strongly suggest that walking would be the best option.

To ensure all children stay safe, please could you fill in the reply slip overleaf to let us know if someone else is going to collect your child from the venue or if your child needs walking back to school if, for instance, they have an after-school club.

Teachers will then have lists of who is and who isn't being collected from the cricket ground and by whom if not yourself.

### Changes for this year's Sports Day:

## Theme of the event: Working as a Team

This year's sports day will have the theme of 'Team Work'. There will be 2 aspects of the day, a Team building side where they will work as a Team to get as many points as possible in a certain activity and then a competitive element where all will take part and perform in a competitive race and everyone will score points for their team wherever they are placed.

### **Maximum participation**

This year, the track and field events will be happening at the same time. This is in order to maximise participation and to reduce hanging around. All Year 5 and 6 will start by competing in a carousel of Team building stations, while Year 3 and 4 will start by competing in 6 competitive track events: Long distance, Sprint, Skipping, Sack, Egg 'n' Spoon and Relay. The children have completed in heats during their Outdoor Games sessions to decide the final runners. We will make it clear on the day with announcements which events are taking place at what time to ensure that you can get to the right spot to watch your child participating.
