If you know your child will be absent on these dates please let us know asap, so that we can amend casting.

As there is limited seating in the hall, we will initially be offering two tickets per family per night, **if ordered before Wednesday 15th June**. Additional tickets will then be available **on a first come first served basis, from Thursday 16th June**. There is only one cast, therefore the roles will be played by the same performers on both nights.

There will be **no charge** for tickets, which will be available via https://theroadtoneverland.eventbrite.co.uk from **Wednesday 8th June**. This year we will also be offering a professionally printed programme, which will need to be ordered in advance via the option on the ticket order form, these will be £3 and will contain photos of every child.

The children will need to be dropped off by **6:15pm** on the evening of the performances. Our fantastic BSA will be selling drinks and nibbles for parents on the back field from this time, weather permitting. In addition, we will take whole cast, individual and small group photos which will then be available to order, more details to follow.
