Year 1 & 2 Living Judaism Visitor in School

Tuesday 5th July 2022

Dear Parents/Carers,

We will be hosting a visitor from Living Judaism on Tuesday 5th July to enrich our RE related to our learning about the Jewish celebration of Shabbat. During the visit, the children will be taking part in making and shaping bread, learning about the significance of bread in different cultures, learning a song and taking part in an act of celebration using the bread they have made. The children will be in small groups with support from teachers and parent helpers.

- The workshop will be in the morning, with normal lessons in the afternoon.
- The groups will be led by Year 1/2 teachers with parent helper volunteers.
- Children should wear normal school uniform.

To cover the cost of the visitor we will be asking for **£1.50 per child** which includes the cost of the ingredients. This is a voluntary contribution, however, if we do not receive enough contributions we will not be able to go ahead with this visit. We receive funding for any families eligible for Pupil Premium, so the cost for these pupils will be paid for from this funding.

Please make an online **ScoPay** payment and click consent if you wish your child to take part in the workshop, we do not accept cash or cheques or paper consent, it is all online.

If your child has any allergies that may relate to bread making and tasting, and/or you do not wish for them to take part please call the school office and let them know.
